A Few Notes:

1. The Puritan-Bennett Goodknight 420E CPAP machine weighs 1.5 lbs. Res Med S8 and Respirationics M series are also small.
2. Masks:
 - Hans Rudolph nasal and full face CPAP masks are *dishwasher safe*.
 - Hypoallergenic masks* include Mirage, Ultra Mirage, and SleepNet IQ products.
 - Activa masks are best for some people with *moustaches or beards*.
3. Some CPAP machines with *built-in international power adaptors*:
 - REM star plus; Devilbiss 9000D; ResMed S7 Elite
4. Some CPAP machines with *built-in heated humidifiers*:
 - REM star plus ; HC210 series ; Polaris EX
